Professor Paul Riegler was born on December, 11th 1867, at town Roman in Moldavia. He entered the Veterinary Medical School in Bucharest that he graduated in 1873, his thesis being entitled: "Bacteriological Researches on Diagnosis of Glanders". In 1900, after a competition, he obtined the department of General Pathology, Microbiology and Pathological Anatomy of the Veterinary School. For 36 years, he carried out a brilliant pedagogical activity in line with his research work. Paul Riegler was a close collaborator of the illustrious scientists: prof. C. Motas, prof. Al. Ciuca, prof. Victor Babeş, prof. Ion Cantacuzino etc. Paul Riegler was also the initiator and leader of many papers in the department of glanders. During the 36 years he worked as professor he published in Romanian Journals as well as in periodicals of great circulation. Professor Rigler's special merit's in the development of General Pathology, Microbiology and Pathological Anatomy, in the creation of the material and human bases of the protection of domestic animals against infectious diseases.
